

## Creative Arts Workshops

### Vision:

- To develop an Art of Life (accredited) programme in prisons, drug and alcohol treatment centres, schools and youth clubs throughout the UK.
- To facilitate multi-sensory workshops, projects, residencies and training using the creative arts as a platform for people to explore issues and develop new ways of expressing themselves and communicating ideas.
- To give people the opportunities to develop literacy skills, computer skills and life skills using creative arts as a tool.
- To equip people with new transferable skills.
- To provide people with the tools, materials, platform and resources to produce portfolios of work that reflect their learning.
- To equip managers, staff, teachers and students with new tools and techniques that they can incorporate into their work and professional development.
- To present a series of quarterly exhibitions called the **Seasons of Life** exhibition that exhibit the work of individuals (Creative Writing Anthologies, Photography, Artwork, CD Compilation Albums, Game and Resources etc). This would also be a charity event where copies of work are sold and money raised will go back to the respective establishments.
- To provide support, guidance and advice about career, training and educational opportunities.
- To provide every participant with a LIFE MAP, Creative Tool Kit.
- To produce a tailored DVD that staff can use as a resource within their work and training.
